School Fees Academic Year 2021/2022

GUIDELINES FOR FEE PAYMENT:

- We do not accept enrolment for less than 1 term.
- Our fee payment is to be paid per term/year
- Short term enrolment (1 term only) will incur an additional 20% fee increase (EYFS International \$200 and \$100 for locals. Primary Internationals \$220 and \$ 110 locals).
- The payments are to be made in the first week of the term.

Cash Payments

Payments in cash at the school can be done **only on the due date**, between **8am and 15:30** by the student's parents or guardian. We only accept the exact amount in large dollar bills (50\$ or 100\$) from 2013 or later. Only the Finances Manager and the Office Manager are allowed to receive cash.

Failure to make payments by the date and time listed will result in the following penalties:

- **\$25 will be charged during the first week that the payment is late.**
- Failure to pay the fees on the term dates detailed above means **no admittance** to your child until the payment is made in full (we do allow a 2 day grace period for the payment to arrive). **Please communicate** with the Office Manager or Headteacher if you are struggling to make the payment.

Understanding School Fees

South East Coast International School is a project of the NGO **South East Coast Education Development**. The school is not-for-profit and therefore all of the

money that comes in goes directly back into the school, for your child's education. The Parent Board are all volunteers and no profit is generated by the activities of the school.

Registration Fee

This is a one time payment covering administrative fees associated with initial enrolment. This must be received along with the completed Registration Form and Contract, **before** the child is admitted to the school.

Please note: Parents are responsible for making payments without reminders from the school. Child illness or leave of absence **does not affect payments**. Parents are still required to pay school fees according to the selected payment plan, regardless of the child's actual attendance. If a month or term is not completed, there will be **no refund**. For children leaving for long periods and coming back you can opt to pay a holding fee of \$50 per month or to pay the Registration Fee again when you come back. You can discuss this with the Office Manager before you leave.

Local and Sponsored Children:

In working towards our aim to promote education for the people of Zanzibar, all Zanzibar or Tanzania families will be charged 50% of the school fee. This discount excludes any child whose parents, or the child him/herself, holds a foreign passport or foreign residency.

In an effort to further support the local community, bring education to the underprivileged of Zanzibar, and create a school based on equality we offer the sponsorship program. A 'sponsored child' is a child whose parents are both Zanzibar or Tanzania, live within the local community and do not have the means to pay even 50% of SEC school fees. Anyone can sponsor a 'local sponsor child' for half of the school fee when we have places available,

currently we are at our maximum capacity.

A sponsor must apply to the office of SEC and there must be long-term commitment for sponsored children. SEC reserves the right to accept or deny the sponsorship based on discretion of the office and the Board. In addition, the SEC will be receiving donations from local businesses, residents and from abroad, which will be used to create a fund to sponsor or offer scholarships to children in need, based on the discretion of the SEC.

Lastly SEC will be welcoming donations from local and international businesses who wish to donate and support the development of the school. We welcome your support and participation on these initiatives.
